The Award:

The **Master of Laws (LL.M.) Program** at Loyola Law School, Los Angeles has partnered with Fulbright Belgium to offer a **\$30,000 grant** for eligible students to pursue the LL.M. degree at Loyola. Eligible students must be citizens of Belgium or Luxembourg, and must hold a first degree in law from a foreign (non-U.S.) jurisdiction. Fulbright will also offer the successful candidate a **travel stipend, sickness and accident insurance, J-visa sponsorship, and access to global Fulbright programming** in Belgium and the United States.

The Program:

Loyola's LL.M. program, designed for foreign law graduates and experienced foreign and U.S. attorneys, allows students to build a flexible curriculum in American law and prepares them to become leaders in a globalized market. Our strong 17,000+ Alumni Network reaches across the U.S. and into 35 different countries, and includes current and former ambassadors, governors, high-level government officials, movie studio executives, and business leaders. The school offers a strong reputation, prominent faculty, and a right-sized LL.M. program that allows faculty and staff to provide personal support to our students throughout their experience.

Specializations

Students may select a broad range of courses, or they may focus on one of the following areas of specialization: Civil Litigation and Advocacy, Criminal Justice, Cybersecurity (pending ABA acquiescence), Entertainment Law, Intellectual Property Law and International Business Law.

Externships

LL.M. students are eligible for externships with academic credit, which enable them to gain practical experience. Loyola has long-standing connections with a wide range of law offices and legal departments throughout Los Angeles and Southern California. LL.M. students have the opportunity to take advantage of these relationships by gaining valuable work experience to complement their coursework.
